The Competitive Armenian Private Sector Program (CAPS) in collaboration with the Russian Armenian (Slavonic) State University established a career center for graduates and students looking to work in the tourism industry.

This effort originated from CAPS USAID funding but is the result of both Slavonic University and CAPS commitment to improving the employment opportunities for graduates while increasing their competitive advantage.

The value to employers is access to a more highly qualified and 'work ready' group of candidates, in addition to possible funding that for internship placements.

The Tourism Career Center, called the Tourism Bridge, was established in early September 2007 and remains open and available to any tourism students or graduates of Armenian Universities or Colleges.

INTERNSHIPS

A limited number of internship opportunities are available for employers who are willing to provide opportunities to graduates interested in tourism employment.

Employers can post internship jobs with the Career Center and the basic qualifications. Staff will then search the database of prospects to find the right match to fit the need.

Interns are given a small stipend for the length of the internship while learning the job, employers then pick up wages after the internship.

SERVICES FOR COMPANIES

The Tourism Bridge can accept your job openings and help pre-screen referrals to send.

In addition to internships we can link you with other methods to find a qualified workforce such as partner organizations and job fairs.

We can also offer prepared Tourism Job Descriptions validated by work with Armenian Tourism companies.
